Looking for family stories that will show the Ohio legislature how important health care coverage is for children and adults



- Are you an uninsured parent(s) with children at home and your income is between 90 and 100% of the federal poverty level (\$15,453 to \$17,170 for a family of three; \$18,585 to \$20,650 for a family of four)?
- Are you a working parent on Medicaid who has been able to keep working because of Medicaid?
- Do you have children who have benefited from Medicaid?
- Are your children uninsured and your family income is between 200 and 300 percent of the federal poverty level (\$34,340 to \$51,510 for a family of three; \$41,300 to \$61,950 for a family of four)? Would your children benefit from expanded Medicaid eligibility?
- Are you an uninsured adult without dependents who has income less than \$115/month and has a chronic medical condition?
- Are you an uninsured working adult of modest means whose employer does not offer health insurance?
- Are you a small employer unable to afford health insurance for your employees?

Ohio's new Governor and many legislators have said they want to expand affordable coverage to more Ohioans. They are debating a two-year state budget bill. We would like to help you tell your story to the Governor and the Legislature!
